Program

The first European Symposium of Photopolymer Science will be held in Mulhouse, France, from November 28th to December 1st, 2010. This conference is devoted to achieve a fundamental understanding of physical chemistry, photochemistry, kinetics, structural and mechanical properties of photopolymers. Generous time for discussions will be included in the program in order to emphasize the workshop character and to stimulate the exchange of new ideas.

The number of participants is strictly limited. The program will be mainly based on invited talks given by eminent scientists working in the field of photopolymers. In addition, contributed papers as well as posters will be accepted.

Abstract

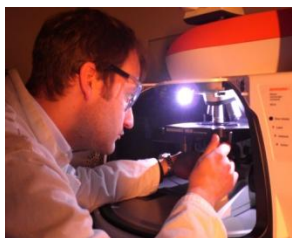
